### 2. Jacaranda Trees – *Jacaranda mimosifolia*

Gauteng's streets are famously lined with Jacarandas, which showcase a majestic display of purple flowers from October through November. These trees can grow up to 20 meters high, turning entire avenues into floral spectacles during their bloom.

### 3. London Plane Trees – *Platanus x hispanica*

Another elegant giant, the London Plane Tree, often lines city streets. Reaching up to 40 meters in height, these deciduous trees are distinguished by their showy white to grey trunks, adding a touch of grace to urban landscapes.

### 4. Fever Trees – *Vachellia xanthophbea*

Indigenous to warmer regions, the Fever Tree is a fast-growing marvel, soaring between 15 to 25 meters tall. Its striking greenish-yellow bark makes it a standout feature in any garden, although it has a shorter lifespan compared to other trees on this list.

### 5. Camphor Trees – *Cinnamomum camphora*

These evergreen, long-living trees are known for their expansive crowns, which can spread even wider than their height of 20 to 30 meters. Camphor Trees provide beautiful, dense shade, making them a cherished addition to any large garden.

These five large trees are often found in small gardens, where they may be planted too close to buildings and houses. Due to limited space, we frequently receive requests to reduce their size.
